- The European Platform of Self-advocates consists of organisations of Self-advocates.
- The European Platform of Self-advocates is a part of Inclusion Europe.
- Self-advocate organisations must be member of Inclusion Europe to join the European Platform of Self-advocates.
- These groups could work in a city, a region or in a country.
- The European Platform of Self-advocates meets at least once every year.
- During this meeting, self-advocate groups elect one chairperson and two vice-chairpersons.



What are the tasks of the European Platform of Self-advocates?

- Help the self-advocacy movement in all European countries to become stronger.
- Represent self-advocacy groups in Europe and in Inclusion Europe.
- Teach self-advocates how they can speak for themselves.
